Dear Parents

Can each of you as parents please do this for your school? I would appreciate it if you could block out half an hour on Saturday morning to come and pray for the school. You would need to be here just before 08:00 and you'll be done by 08:30. We'll meet just outside Reception and you'll go to various prayer stations around the school.

Our idea for Saturday morning is based around these Scriptures:

..... he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray (Matt 14:23)

..... Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed (Mk 1:35)

..... but Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed (Luke 5:16)

When you arrive at school, we'll have a map for you indicating the different stations where a list of prayer needs and praises will be listed. On your own time, you may visit the various prayer stations to offer up prayers and petitions to God.

During the days of Jesus life on earth, he offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission. Although he was a son, he learned obedience from what he suffered (Hebrews 5:7-8).

While I know that Saturday mornings can be very busy for all of you, I'm asking that you take this short time to come and pray at school. You have planted your children, with all the hopes and dreams that you have for their future, in this school and our corporate prayer is immensely valuable. Don't put it off until the next prayer meeting – a sign outside a nursery in Canada would just as easily apply to our children:

The best time to plant a tree is twenty five years ago. The second best time is today.

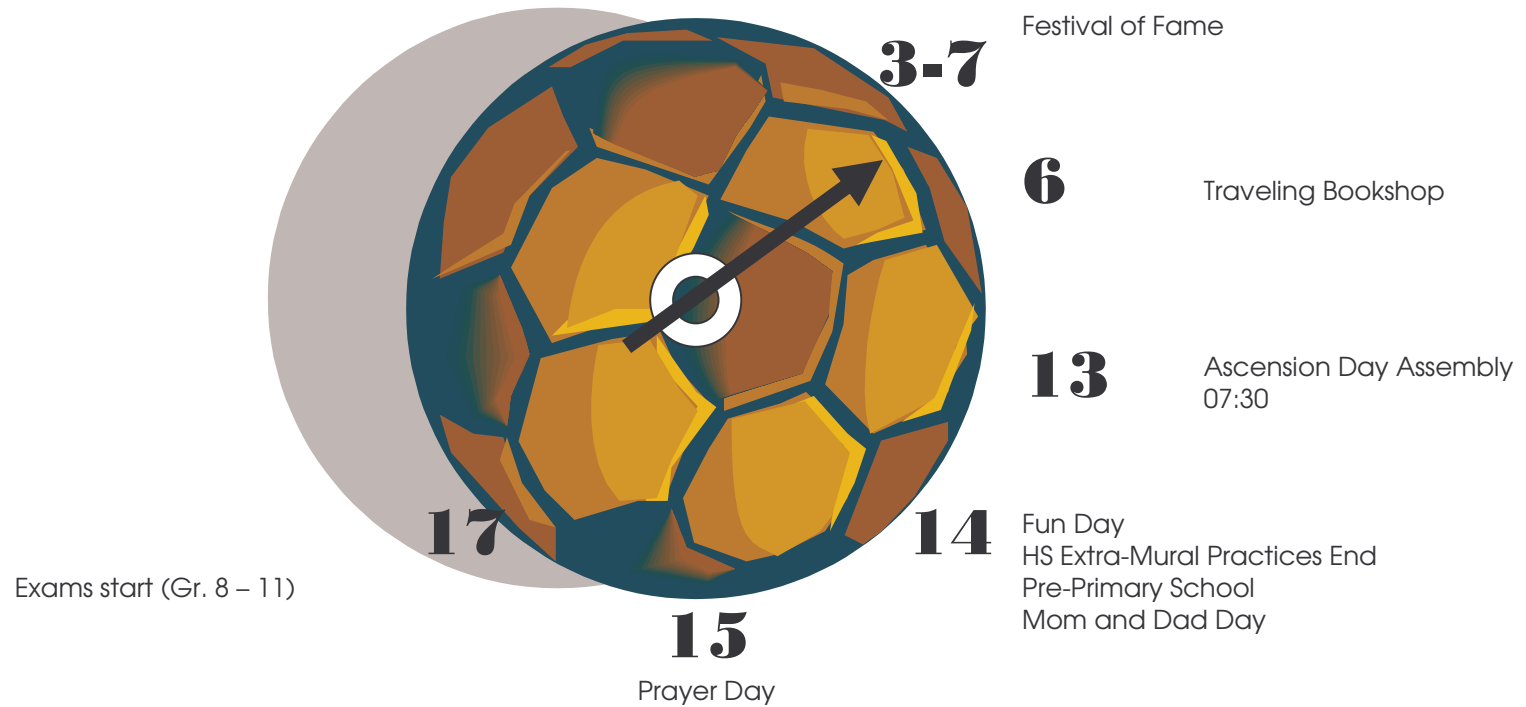
### **ASCENSION DAY ASSEMBLY**
