LET'S TALK MONEY!

The World Cup is over. Congratulations to Spain's soccer team. The World Champions walked away with prize money totaling US\$30 million and the South African Football Association earned R77 million for soccer development in the country.

But for South Africa in general we're recovering from the financial outlay in an economy that is slowly emerging from recession.

It is also a privilege for our school to be hosting a Crown Ministries Personal Financial Planning course at our school (see enclosed leaflet). The material looks good, with a strong emphasis on practical application and Biblical truth and we encourage as many parents as possible to register.

The third term is the time of the year when we prepare our annual budget. We would appreciate your sincere and fervent prayer in this regard.

And as we get back to a routine that doesn't have soccer or vuvuzelas in it, here's a great bit of advice I came across from Wendell Berry:

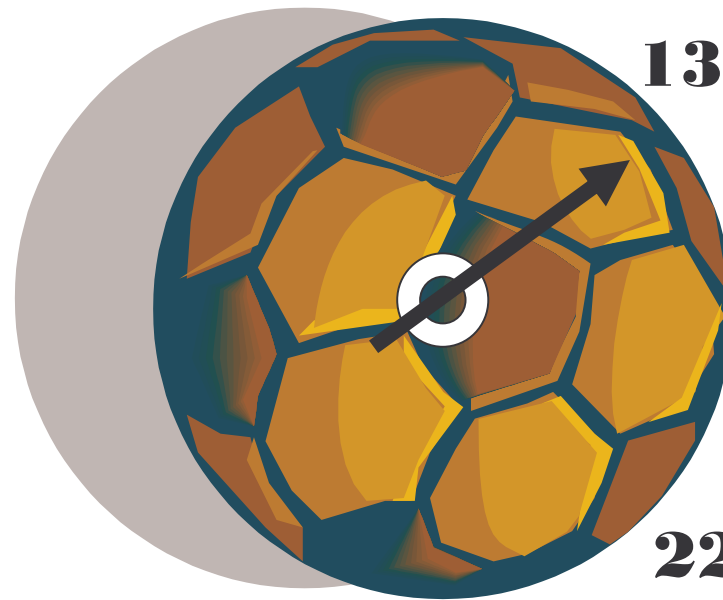
We should waste less, spend less, use less, want less, need less.
